


# Excel Function

Description	Example																								
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>How to write<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>When entering the '=' character in a cell, the cell coordinates will be exposed and the status will be changed to the function input mode.</li><li>When the '=' character is removed, the cell coordinates will be removed and the status will be changed to normal text input.</li></ul></li><li>How to complete<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>When the Enter key is operated, the entered function will be calculated and the result will be displayed, and it will be changed to a cell selection.</li><li>When the caret gets out of the cell judged to be a function, the formula will be calculated and the results will be displayed.</li></ul></li><li>How to edit the written Excel functions<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>When the caret is moved to the cell where the formula is calculated, the entered function (or formula) will be displayed.</li><li>At this time, the caret always moves to the very front of the cell.</li></ul></li></ul> <p>Note: Even if the = character included in the string comes first, the status does not change to the function input mode. - Conditions not calculated
  - If a cell contains objects (tables, horizontal lines, images, videos, etc.) other than functions (or formulas), the formulas are not processed.
  - If properties other than normal text (tabs, line breaks, hyperlinks) are included, the formulas are not processed.
  - If bullets and quotation marks are included, the formulas are not processed.
  - Objects (images, videos, tables, etc.) cannot be moved to the cells processed with functions (or formulas).
