

# Using base64 Images

With 'editor.upload.image.base64' setting, you may determine if you will use base64 image when you upload images (default - false).

If set to true, when an image is inserted, the image will not be uploaded to the server but, instead, will be encoded into base64 image and displayed in the body.

## synapeditor.config.js

```
{  
    'editor.upload.image.base64': false,  
}
```
