public setLock(selector: String)

It limits editing by specifying a DOM selector.
When applied, it is represented by a lock icon ().

Applicable to

- DIV
 - Elements with "se-contents" and "se-div" classes specified
- TABLE
- TD
- TH

Params: selector

Name	Type	Description
selector	string	Selectors to import the DOM to limit editing

Example:

```
window.editor.setLock('#lock_element_Id');
window.editor.setLock('.not_editable');
```

Source view
