

# getHTMLElements

RELEASE 2.11.0 OR ABOVE

Returns an array of HTML Elements based on Selection. If no Selection is specified, returns the HTML Element corresponding to the current Selection.

## Parameters:

Name	Type	Attribute	Description
<code>selectionObject</code>	Object	<pre>{   anchor: {     Position },   focus: {     Position } }</pre>	[ Optional ] A selection object with an anchor position and a focus position. If this value is not present, it operates based on the current selection.

## Return:

Type	Description
HTML Element []	An array of HTML Elements corresponding to Selection. In the caret state, the HTML Element where the caret is located is returned as an array.

## Example:

### If selection is not specified

```
var elements = editor.getHTMLElements();
console.log(elements[0].innerHTML);
```

### If selection is specified

```
var selection = editor.getSelection();
var elements = editor.getHTMLElements(selection);
console.log(elements[0].innerHTML);
```
